

WE'RE UPGRADING BEAUDESERT'S RESERVOIR

June 2021

You can rely on us to keep things flowing, and from time-to-time we need to upgrade your local water network.

What's happening?

Our delivery partner, Downer WSP, will soon start work on the existing reservoir along Birnam Range Road, Beaudesert. The project will include roof demolition and replacement, as well as rehabilitation improvements to the reservoir. Construction will start from **late - June 2021** and we expect to be finished by **October 2021**, weather and site conditions permitting.

Why is this happening?

We are improving the sustainability of our infrastructure by undertaking this project as part of a two-year capital works program across the Scenic Rim Region. Refurbishing the asbestos cement reservoir roof, will future proof the reliability of our network and ensure long-term service delivery to the community for the next 40 years.

How will impacts be managed?

Safety – barriers and signage around work areas will be in place to keep everyone safe.

Hours- most of the work will take place during the day, between **6am and 6pm**, Monday to Friday. To comply with traffic permits, we may need to carry out some work at night between **7pm and 5am**. We will notify you before any night work occurs.

Traffic changes- possible lane and road closures around work sites. Traffic management will be in place to look after the safety of our pedestrians and road users.

Water outages- we'll give you at least three days' notice before any planned water interruptions to your water supply. Keep a look out in your letterbox for these updates.

Noise and dust- unfortunately there will be varying levels during excavation. We will minimise these where we can.

Restoration- temporary restoration at worksites will occur while work is in progress. At completion, we'll restore as close to the original condition as possible.

Asbestos removal – there are no health risks associated with drinking water that has been contained in the asbestos cement reservoir. Our licensed asbestos removers will safely remove these sections by wetting down the asbestos cement before it is removed and disposing of it in a special bin.
