

# Working beneath the streets

## Coronation Drive, Toowong

19 February 2021

You can rely on us to keep things flowing, and from time-to-time we need to upgrade your local water and wastewater pipes.

### What is happening?

Our delivery partner, Diona, will soon start work on upgrading our water pipe along a section of **Coronation Drive, Toowong (from Archer Street, on the even side of Coronation Drive to the guardrail located outside 576 Coronation Drive)**. We'll start work on the corner of Archer Street and Coronation Drive on **Wednesday 3 March**, weather and site conditions permitting.

### Why is this happening?

This pipe is nearing the end of its serviceable life. Upgrades to the network will ensure that we can keep moving the water to your taps. The pipes are within Council land in the road and footpath in front of residential housing, so we will not need to enter your property.

Due to traffic permit requirements, our working hours will be from **7:00 pm to 6:00 am, Monday to Saturday**.

- Archer Street – 15 Feb. to 2 Mar. 2021\*

**Bicentennial Bikeway, and pedestrian access**

During these works, pedestrian and cyclist traffic will be diverted from the bikeway along Coronation Drive as per approved Traffic Guidance Schemes, please refer to maps displayed onsite closer to the starting dates.

**Parking, and traffic access**

Our work areas will be behind barriers. Please observe all site signage and barriers – they are there to keep you and our workers safe. Lane/road closures will be required however local resident and business access to driveways will always be maintained. You may experience minor delays when work is taking place in front of your property. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and general traffic around work areas.

**Noise and dust**

The work will have elevated noise levels at times as we dig down to expose the old pipe and work to lay the new one. We will try and keep noise and any dust generated to a minimum.

**Temporary water service**

To replace the pipes, we will need to temporarily disconnect properties while we work to transfer you to the new water main. We'll give you at least five days' notice prior to any temporary water outage. Keep a look out in your letterbox for the update.

**Restoration/trees**

Please be aware that temporary resurfacing to roads, driveways and pedestrian paths will be in place during our works. After we have completed installing each section of pipe, we will be restoring these areas. All of the works are within the existing bikeway.

**Important information for Building Managers**

We recommend Building Managers contact the relevant fire and equipment service provider for advice preparing your building systems before the interruption because fire alarms, sprinkler systems, domestic water pumps, tanks and cooling towers might be affected by water interruptions.
