

Working beneath the streets

Meredith Street, Banyo 27 March 2023

What is happening?

Our delivery partner, Diona, will soon start water mains replacements along Meredith Street, Banyo, between Langton Street and Earnshaw State College. Construction will commence from Monday 3 April 2023 for approximately three weeks. Works will take place during the day from 6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Timelines are indicative only and subject to site and weather conditions.



Why is this happening?

The pipes near your property are reaching the end of their life cycle and upgrades to the network will ensure that we can keep moving the water to your taps. The pipes are within Council land, so we will not need to enter your property.

Pedestrian and vehicle access

Local access will be maintained; however, pedestrian path closures may be in place while we are working near your property. Traffic control will be in place, although you may experience minor temporary traffic delays.

Temporary water outages

To replace the pipes, we may need to temporarily disconnect properties while we work to transfer you to the new water main. Affected properties will be given at least three days' notice prior to any temporary water outage.





Temporary water service

We might need to connect your property to a temporary water pipe to maintain your water supply. Water quality will remain unchanged; however, you may notice a slight reduction in water pressure. The pipe is usually laid across driveways and a crossing ramp will be placed to maintain safe vehicle access and protect the pipe. Please cross the ramp at a slow speed to avoid damaging it.

Compound area (site storage area)

As part of our works a storage area will be set up between 63 and 67 Meredith Street (please see above map). You may experience increased levels of noise caused by vehicle movements and the use of machinery, as well as construction crews and equipment being present. The compound area will be restored as close as reasonably possible when the work is complete.

Noise and dust

We acknowledge that our works may have elevated noise and dust levels at times. We will minimise our impacts where possible and do our best to complete all high impact avoidable noise activities early in the shift, weather and site conditions permitting.

Restoration and driveways

We will be restoring as close as reasonable possible to pre-existing condition all impacted areas including roads, driveways, and footpaths.
